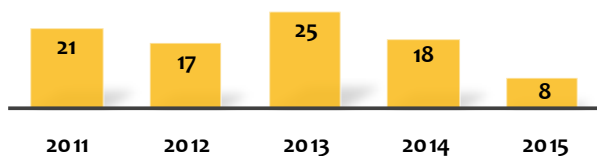
Part One Crimes*

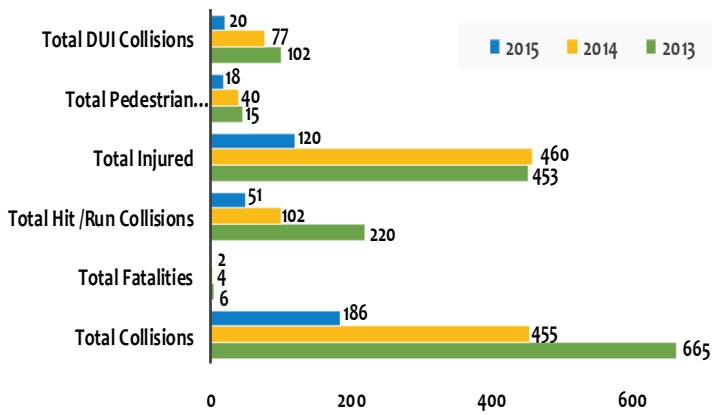

Community Engagement

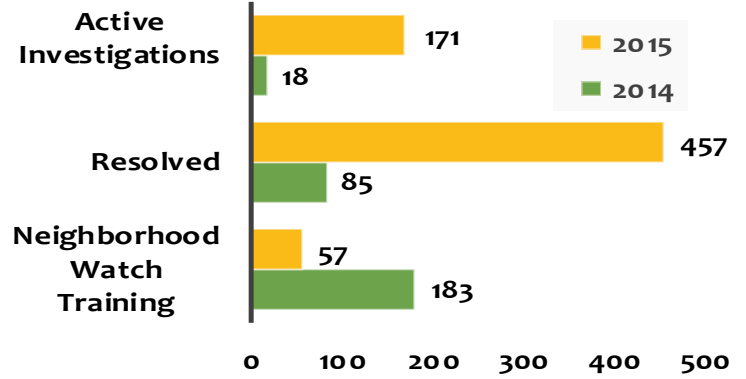

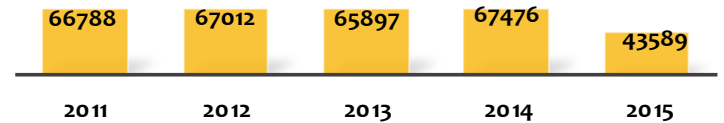
