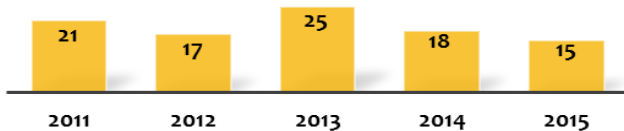
### Part One Crimes\*

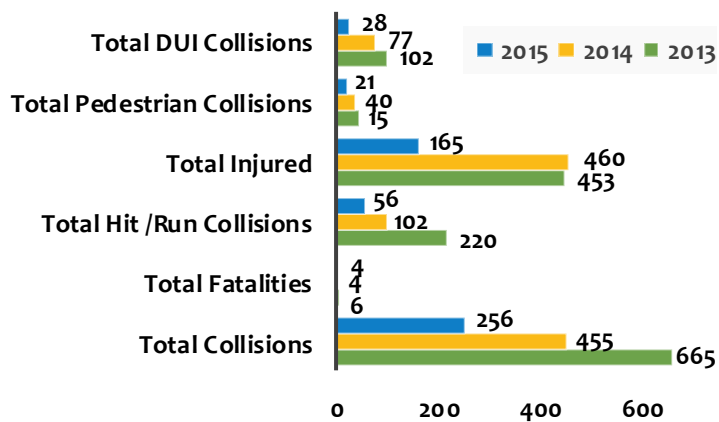

## Community Engagement

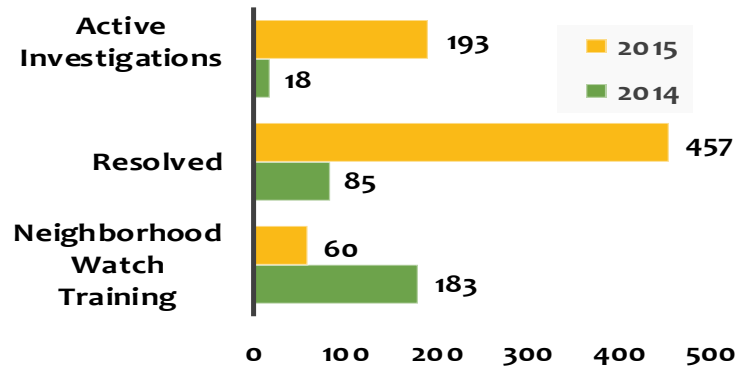

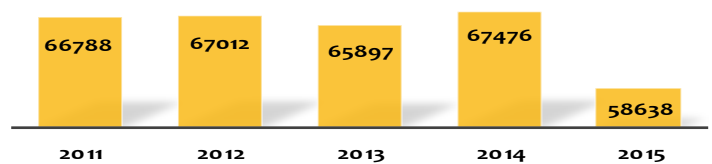
