VALLEJO POLICE DEPARTMENT INVESTIGATES MULTIPLE STABBING INCIDENT LEAVING ONE WOMAN MURDERED

Vallejo, CA - On Sunday, July 19, 2020, at approximately 07:55 AM, Vallejo police patrol officers responded to a residence on the 100 Block of Byron Street for a reported stabbing.

When officers arrived, they discovered a 49-year-old Black female suffering from at least one stab wound. The female victim was transported to a local hospital where she was pronounced deceased.

A 25-year-old Black male was located outside of the residence suffering from multiple stab wounds. The male victim was transported to a local hospital in critical condition.

Officers also made contact with a 26-year-old Black female suspect outside of the residence, who was suffering from apparent stab wounds and was transported to a local hospital in stable condition.

The female suspect has been identified as the daughter of the 49-year-old deceased woman and the sister of the 25-year-old male victim. Both women were identified as residents of New Orleans, Louisiana and were visiting in Vallejo. The male victim is a Vallejo resident.

The 26-year-old female suspect, whose name is being withheld pending further investigation, was arrested for the murder of her mother and the attempted murder of her brother.

The Solano County Coroner's Office will release the identity of the deceased pending confirmation and notification of next of kin. The identity of the male victim is also being withheld at this time.

Two children of the male victim, an infant and 3-year-old, were also located inside the residence. The children are now safe with family. A Vallejo Police Chaplain was called out to the scene to help provide comfort and support for the children and family of the involved parties.

This is the City of Vallejo's 15th murder.
